Irresistible Offa

Montgomery West

- From the castle car park, walk along the Llandyssil road with the castle on your right, until you reach the finger posts to the left and right.
- Climb the stile on your right and cross the field towards the woodlands, noting the ramparts and outwork of Fridd Faldwyn hillfort on your left. There are wonderful views over the Severn Valley.
- Throughout the woodland there are signs of earthworks.

 Earliest activity here came in the Neolithic period. Two thousand years later, communities from the Late Bronze Age and Iron Age created a defended enclosure with upright timbers and ditches.
- Follow the path as it descends and bends to the right, eventually leaving the woodland and crossing a field. After a stretch on the pavement beside the B4385 head back towards the town.
- As the town approaches take a right at the crossroads up Arthur Street. Then once approaching the Town hall take a right up the hill and back towards the Castle car park. Its well worth walking from the car park to the castle the remains and views are wonderful.
